



# Working with Couples

## Workshop in Christchurch with Walter Logeman

If you work with couples, or would like to, this workshop is for you. The aim is to build on the work you already do and to gain confidence and competence with couples. Whatever your training, you will learn to be present with the couple. This is professional development work. You will be invited to identify your strengths and build on them in such a way as to enhance your practice.

We use psychodramatic methods and principles to *learn together*.

The theme for this event is "*stepping into your partners shoes*". Assisting partners to listen to each other is central to couple therapy. Listening enables the other to talk. To put it another way, the theme of this event is to assist partners to *be* (in their bodies) in such a way the other opens, accesses their experience, and heals. Learn to be there for the couple in moments of activation and eruption.

I am a Psychodramatist and a Trainer, Educator and Practitioner (TEP) in the psychodrama method. I have a postgraduate degree in social work, I'm an Imago Relationship Therapist and a member of NZAP. I work in private practice as a couple therapist, group worker and supervisor. I've conducted *Working with Couples* workshops since 2009.
